

Prosecco, a uniquely Italian sparkling wine, is arguably the fastest growing wine brand in the world.

Produced in Italy's north east, the true home of Prosecco lies between the Dolomites and Venice in the Veneto region.

Established in the 1960's, San Martino is a 'grower/producer', with extensive vineyard holdings of both DOC and DOCG vineyard sites.

San Martino DOC is produced via the Charmat method, with each order for Australia being processed fresh ready for export.

It is fair to claim that any bottle of San Martino enjoyed in Australia is no older than 3-4 months—freshness is one of the keys to this style.

San Martino Prosecco is 'extra dry', best described as having a thread of sweetness behind the up front green apple/melon fruit flavours.

Perfectly balanced [natural] acidity ensures both a lively palate and a clean, long finish.

San Martino Prosecco is an aperitif style, well suited to canapés such as melon wrapped in Prosciutto.
